

Code of Conduct

The Netball NSW Code of Behaviour Policy forms one part of the <u>Netball NSW Member Protection</u> <u>Policy</u>, and as such, should be read in conjunction with the Member Protection Policy.

Netball NSW requires every individual and organisation bound by the Member Protection Policy to:

- Be ethical, fair, considerate and honest in all their dealings with other people and Netball NSW;
- Treat all persons with respect and courtesy and have proper regard for their dignity, rights and obligations;
- Always place the safety and welfare of children above other considerations;
- Comply with Netball NSW's constitution, rules and policies including the Member Protection Policy;
- Operate within the rules and spirit of the sport;
- Comply with all relevant Australian laws (Federal and State), particularly anti-discrimination and child protection laws;
- Be responsible and accountable for their conduct; and
- Abide by the relevant Netball Australia Role-Specific Codes of Behaviour.

All players, coaches, managers, parents, administrators are required to read and abide by the <u>Netball</u> <u>NSW Code of Behaviour Policy</u>. In addition to the General Code of Behaviour, Netball NSW has developed role-specific Codes of Behaviour including, but not limited to:

- Administrators
- Coaches
- Players
- Umpires
- Parents/Guardians
- Spectators
